

## ENGLISH

To begin the term, we will finish innovating 'Kassim and the Greedy Dragon'. After we will learn and innovate our own version of 'Jack and the Beanstalk.'

## RE

We will start by finding out about 'What places are special and why?' After half term the children find out 'What is the good news Christians believe Jesus brings?'

## PSHE

We will start by finding out about *Safety and Changing Bodies*. Then Citizenship, finding out about why we have rules and similarities and differences between ourselves.

## FRENCH

The children's French knowledge is taught in a covert manner through songs, rhymes and simple phrases. This term we focus on answering the register.

## MATHEMATICS

In KS1, following White Rose Maths, the following areas will be covered: Money, Fractions, Time, Mass Capacity and temperature and Position and Direction

Reception will continue to explore number using the Mastery of Number approach. The lessons build children's number sense.

## SCIENCE

The children will focus on the unit *Plants*. The children will have first-hand experiences growing seeds and bulbs and observe how they grow into mature plants. They will also investigate what plants need to grow.

## HISTORY

This term the children will be focusing on the topic *Transport*. In this topic children will look at how transport has changed across the time periods. They will also find out about significant individuals (e.g. Stevenson and Brunel -) and how they changed transport.

## Geography

The children will find out about live in the Zambian village of Mugurameno. Children will use maps and aerial photography to support their learning.

## PE

In art, the children will explore creating prints from different materials. They will study the work of Williams Morris. In DT, the children will be exploring wheels and axels to create their own vehicle.
